- IFFCO not importing Phos. Acid. Long ago they maid few trial shipments of Phos Acid loading as coastal cargo from Paradip to Kandla. Now IFFCO not doing any Import or Export of Phos. Acid.
- Edible Oil Tankers can berth at Port's Multipurpose berth where M/s. Cargil has Shore Pipe Line facility to receive cargo
- Fert Berth No 2 and Fert. Berth No.1 also can be used for discharging Edible Cargo by connection extendable shore pipe lines when Multipurpose Berth not Free and subject to availability of FB 2 and FB 1 with special permission from Port Chairman
- As per port norms, vessel must maintain mean draft of 5 M and trim should be less than 2 M during departure/sailing.
- Bunker / Fresh water supply possible
- Round the clock navigation
- Vessels ageing over 20 years will be inspected by port authorities at anchorage for acceptance at Paradeep port
- No first come first berth basis at PPL and IFFCO berths, berthing is as per receiver's cargo priority requirement and planning.
- Bunker supply possible at berth by Tank Lorries. At present IOCL can supply only Duty Paid Marine Gas Oil.
- Fresh water and bunker supply possible at berth by Shore Connection and By Barge. However, supply by barges at Anchorage stricly not permitted and no barge available for such arrangements.
